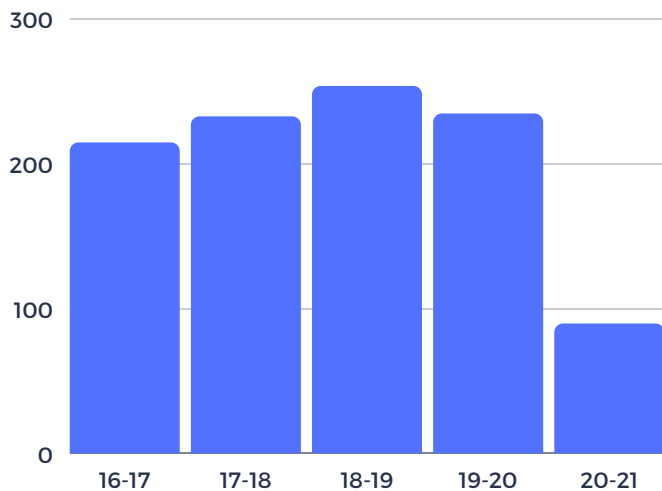

Library instruction sessions, 2016-2021

FEWER INSTRUCTION SESSIONS

2020-2021 brought many unexpected changes to the library instruction program. COVID-19 transitioned all instruction online, the library lost a librarian and large contributor to instruction, and the University experienced an 11% decrease in total undergraduate enrollment. It is these circumstances that led to a 62% decrease in instruction sessions in 2020-2021.

MORE ONLINE CONTENT

To support instructors' transition to remote teaching, librarians developed material in new modalities of library instruction: information literacy lessons in Canvas, video tutorials on YouTube, and digital guides to research.

We also saw increased engagement with digital content. Our digital guides to research had an 18% increase in views in 2020-2021.
