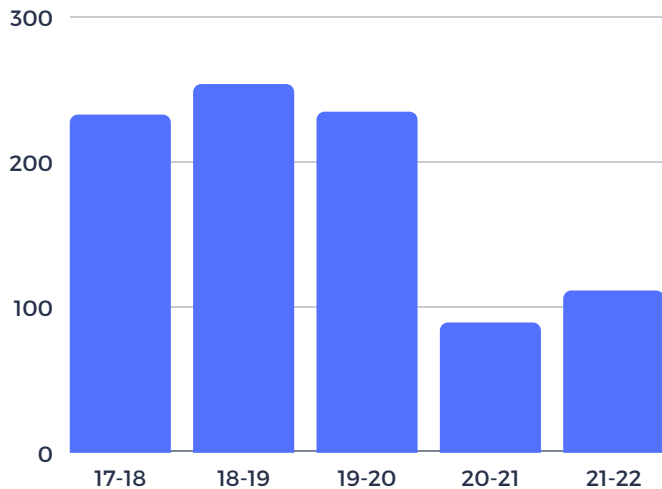

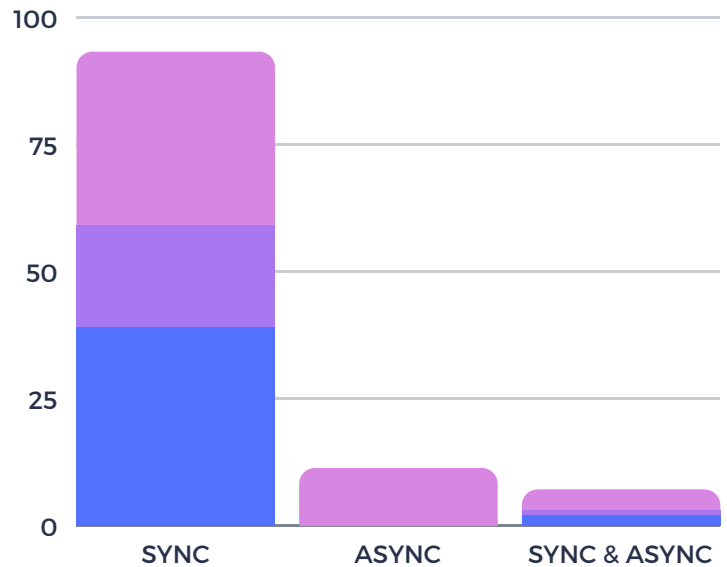
LIBRARY INSTRUCTION PROGRAM, 2021-2022

BABY STEPS

In 2021-2022, the Library Instruction Program saw a 25% increase in library instruction sessions from the previous year. The increase demonstrates that the library instruction program is rebuilding after the steep drop off during the COVID-19 pandemic when Sonoma State transitioned entirely to remote learning,

FLEXIBLE MODALITIES

As Sonoma State returns to face-to-face instruction, librarians continued to offer instruction in a variety of modalities: as traditional, face-to-face classroom meetings, work students can complete on their own time, or online Zoom meetings.

While the majority of instruction was synchronous, meaning it happened in real-time, librarians offered this instruction in a variety of locations, demonstrating flexibility in offerings.
